TEST-01 - Assessment

This associated reflective practice can be defined as planned and deliberate activities that engage the students in a critical manner with the relationship between conceptual, theoretical and practical concerns in the content and context of visual art.

In the Second Year these concerns are strongly related to the themes of the Studio course.

Part of the Studio Classroom is that students participate in associated reflective events, such as public lectures or seminars, symposia or artist talks.
