Content

Graduation Thesis

At the end of the programme, the students present a thesis that demonstrates a critical, reflective attitude regarding their own work, and indicates the specific position the students wish to assume with this work in relation to the surrounding culture and art world. The thesis demonstrates the capacity to analyse, critically review and reflect, and reveals the investigative attitude of the student.

The instructional modes are graduation project, individual, intervention, supervision. Active attendance and participation are mandatory to receive a total of 5 EC, which include Presentation and Content.
