The student

- makes a profound study of his domain
- The student demonstrates the (self)critical ability to determine his own criteria and act accordingly

Product

The student

- makes an exhibition of an interrelated series of artistic works which manifests professional competence, an individual vision and attitude
- demonstrates that research and reflection are interrelated with the visual practice
- demonstrates an entrepreneurial spirit, inventiveness and steadfastness and goes to any length
- demonstrates the ambition to excel as an artist

Context

The student

- writes a brief, concise *artist statement*
- places his work, attitude, vision and process in a broader context
- shows a clear insight into his professional context
- demonstrates knowledge of and insight into the current events of the occupational sector on a practical and theoretical level
- aims to take a professional position as an artist

Content

The course *Studio classroom* in semester 7 supports the collaborative teaching and studio-based teaching. A theory teacher supervises the students to become focused on contemplation and positioning through practice-led research, resulting in a Graduation Thesis in semester 8.
