In the Fourth Year the studio is a personal place but it may also be an art, design or performance space, workshop, or a constructed social environment in a virtual space. A collaborative team of two artist-teachers guides the students through the Studio course in the making and the presenting of ideas and images from self-determined, but professional conditions, and in establishing a self-generating, flexible and resilient studio practice. In the fourth year <i>Studio</i> the student consolidates a professional practice through critical reflection and feedback in the studio environment. Individual and collaborative projects within the framework of studio practice are set up to determine the students' artistic positions. One of the two Studio teachers is co-reader and co-assessor for the Graduation Thesis.
