Learning outcomes

After the course you will be able to do the following at an advanced level:

- 1.2 You make music that is related to relevant musical contexts and can justify this on the basis of theory and research.
- 2.2 You initiate and/or contribute to collective and/or individual creative (making) processes.
- 3.1 You show awareness of what is happening in the world/society and recognize the relevance of this for your own music.
- 4.1 You reflect on (the development of) your own and other people's artistry, quality, vision and identity.
- 5.1 You bring musical work (on- and offline) to the outside world.
- 6.2 You organize work processes in such a way that artistic, business, organizational and/or social activities are carried out coherently and in a balanced way.

Content

You will receive coaching in the craft of mastering and artistic application of your instrument/discipline (major, minor, practicum). In addition, you will do an internship and/or learn at a workplace, analyze polyphonic music (solfege), develop working from a score and participate in the choir. During this course you will also develop a plan for your graduation project. You will work on, among other things:

- developing (music) professional knowledge and skills and applying them in complex professional situations and contexts within and outside your domain (1);
- deepening your artistic vision and identity (2);
- individually and/or collectively creating artistic work in complex professional situations (2);
- following developments in the field, society and establishing relationships and connections with your own musical context (3);
- methodically evaluating (your own and others') performances in complex professional situations (4).
- sharing your own music/work via appropriate online and offline methods and strategies (5);
- deepening your artistic/educational practice (6).
- the application of didactic methods and strategies in complex, interdisciplinary professional situations (7).
